Application Procedures	The Refund Applicant must apply <u>In Person</u> to the Kowloon East Campus (28 Wang Hoi Road, Kowloon Bay, Kowloon) and provide the following documents (signed on each page): a. <u>Original and Copy</u> of i. supporting document(s) to prove the acceptance of an official offer from the eligible programmes (e.g. offer letter, payment receipt and/or student card of the offering institution which shows the <u>name</u> and the <u>programme title</u> of the applicant); ii. HKU SPACE receipt for the enrolment deposit and, if applicable, the first instalment of tuition fee; iii. HKID card; and b. <u>Copy</u> of a valid bank account document (e.g. first page of the bank passbook/bank statement which clearly shows the name of account holder and the account number)	
Fee	5% of the eligible amount will be charged as administrative fee for each successful refund application. The administrative fee will be deducted from the eligible amount and the Refund Applicant will receive a refund net of the administrative fee.
