2) a separate Statement of Attendance issued by HKU SPACE.

The University of London LLB was the first English law degree offered since the 1890s. It is also the first law degree provided in Hong Kong, having been introduced by HKU SPACE in 1963/4, making it the inaugural program of HKU SPACE.

For over 130 years, UoL LLB is internationally accepted as a prerequisite academic qualification to qualify as a lawyer in many Common Law jurisdictions, including Hong Kong and England and Wales, Australia, the United States and Canada.

Upon graduation, you'll become part of our global as well as HK-UoL alumni networks of lawyers, solicitors, barristers, and judges.

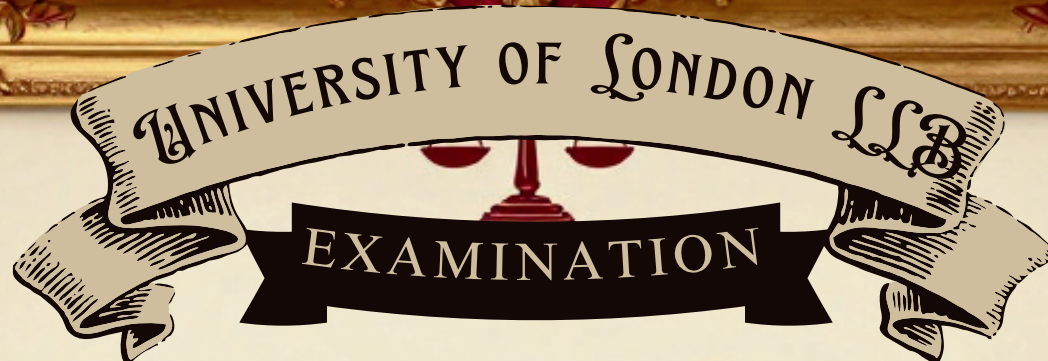

Entrance Requirements for the 3 Routes

Graduate Entry	A degree in non-law discipline; or equivalent
Standard Entry	5 HKDSE Category A subjects at Level 33 (including English Language) + 222 or + 22A; OR - Passed in 2 'A' levels and 3 'O' levels (not necessarily obtained in one sitting) or equivalent; OR - International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBDP); OR - Associate Degree or Diploma holders; or equivalent
CertHE Entry	- Aged 18 or above on or before the date of programme registration; AND - Pass the entrance test and attend an interview; AND - Demonstrate a good level of English; AND - Register with HKU SPACE as Recognised Teaching Centre of University of London.

UNIVERSITY OF LONDON EXAMINATIONS

There are 2 examination periods in each academic year - May/June and October. In May/June exam, students can sit for up to 4 examinations in their first year of study. In the October exam, students can sit a maximum of 2 examinations.

Starting November 2025, a 25% multiple-choice component has been included in all Level 4 (Year 1) modules and three Level 5 (Year 2) modules, will also have MCQs in May 2027.

The examination syllabus of each year is set out by the University of London in their Law Prospectus. The details will also be given to you when you have the offer from the LLB. Normally, registration for local examinations in Hong Kong shall be done via the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority, which is responsible for administering the University of London examinations.

MODULES/ CREDITS RECOGNITION AND TRANSFER

Students may apply to transfer their studies to London, including possible direct entry to Year 2 or even Year 3 of full-time LLB programmes at the University of London, relying on credits earned from studying via HKU SPACE for the University of London Worldwide LLB.



HKU SPACE Preparation Courses are intended for those having the right to live and study in HK and it is the responsibility of applicants to determine their eligibility to study. Please refer to "Notes to Non-local Applicants" on the application for enrolment form.

COURSE MATERIALS, ONLINE SUPPORT AND LIBRARY ACCESS

University of London will provide Module Guides, statute books (where provided), UOL Student Portal Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) and the Online Library. It provides free access to professional legal databases, etc.

HKU SPACE UK visiting lecturers will provide supplementary materials, including lecture outlines, handouts, and legal updates. Students on HKU SPACE Preparation Courses will have access to the School's online learning platform (SOUL). Each student will be provided HKU Library Reader's Card, which may be upgraded to Borrower's Card upon paying an extra fee.

OUR LLB PREPARATION COURSES

Main lectures run from October to January and revision lectures run from March/April. There will be lectures focusing on exam preparation and writing skills, and students will have an opportunity to submit written work in advance of these lectures. Mock Exams will be held in February/March.

QUALIFY AS LAWYER AROUND THE WORLD

Hong Kong PCLL

As the very first formal legal training in Hong Kong dated back to 1960s, the University of London LLB has long been accepted for the purpose of PCLL admission and is among the most welcomed qualifications. Since the LLB is regarded as a non-local legal qualification, holders will need to take PCLL admission conversion exams to obtain full eligibility. But following HKU SPACE study plan and with HKU SPACE own prep courses for the conversion exams, London students studying with HKU SPACE are always best supported.

Admission in Other Jurisdictions

With the London LLB, many HKU SPACE alumni have successfully been admitted to practice in Canada, California, New York, etc. HKU SPACE has been providing numerous testimonies to professional bodies in different jurisdictions for our alumni on their study and attendance record of LLB courses.

England and Wales

SQE

The Solicitors Qualifying Examination (SQE) opens to degree holders in any subject intending to be qualified as solicitors. But a prestigious formal law degree still puts you in a better position and is favored by law firms. Our LLB will give you a solid foundation to pass the SQE assessments. SQE includes two assessments: SQE1 and SQE2. SQE1 assesses functioning legal knowledge (FLK). Most of the FLK areas are covered in the LLB curriculum.

England and Wales

Bar Training

You still need a qualifying law degree (minimum 2:2 classification) or a non-law degree plus a Graduate Diploma in Law to fulfill the academic stage if you want to become a barrister. Your law degree must include seven foundations of legal knowledge which are all covered in the LLB curriculum.

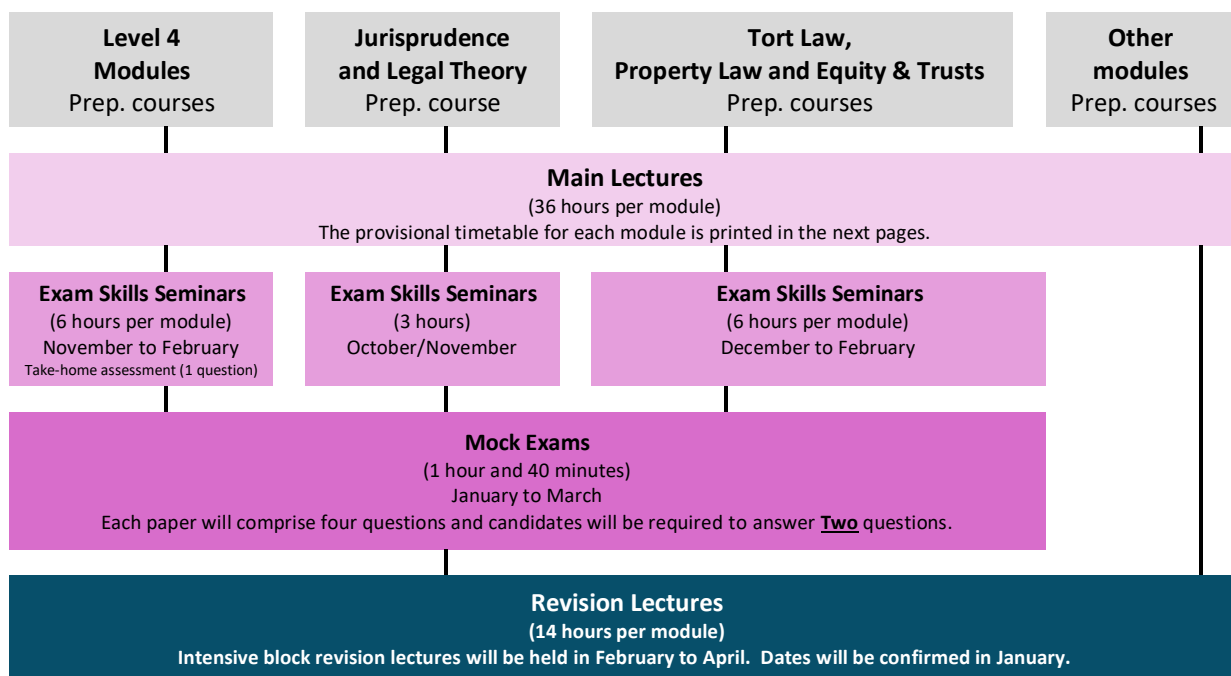
