Programme Structure

This programme covers 13 topics in 2 modules in 8 months and the lectures will be arranged every Tuesday night. Visits will be organized to sea container terminal, air cargo terminal or the like during the course.

The aims for this programme are:

1. To provide industry practitioners, especially the new entrants a comprehensive training programme on the basics of shipping and logistics operations.
2. To provide practitioners an academic progression path that leads to higher academic / professional qualifications through this programme.

Course Fee

Entry Requirement

Applicants shall:

- (a) Attained Hong Kong Diploma in Secondary Education (HKDSE) Level 2 or above in 5 subjects including English Language; or
- (b) Attained Hong Kong Certificate of Education Grade E/ Level 2 or above in 5 subjects including English Language; or
- (c) 1 year relevant work experience at supervisory level in shipping and logistics industry; or
- (d) Completed Form 5/Secondary 6 with employer's recommendation endorsed by the Hong Kong Shippers' Council

Programme Delivery

The lectures are normally conducted in English, supplemented by Cantonese.

Handouts and examinations are in English.
