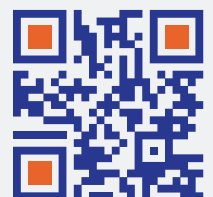

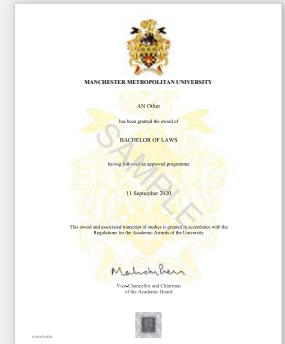

- Holders of Advanced Diploma for Legal Executives (Graduate Level)
- Holders of Common Professional Examination Certificate in Laws (CPEC)
- Holders of other Graduate Diplomas in Law (if space still available)

- Please note that the programme is intended for those who having the right to live and study in Hong Kong. It is a very unlikely that an “overseas” applicant will be granted a visa to study this non-UGC funded programme and it is the responsibility of applicants to determine their eligibility to study.

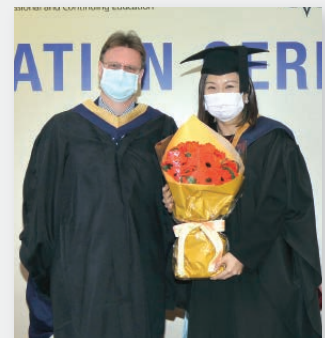
