Study mode and assessments

This program is delivered part-time.

Distance learning is supplemented by local face-to-face tutorials (no tutorial for core subjects INF220, INF221, INF222 and INF305).

3 sessions per year: Session 1 (Feb–Jun), Session 2 (Jul–Oct) and Session 3 (Nov–Feb).

Subjects are assessed by coursework, with no examinations. Coursework is marked by Charles Sturt subject coordinators.

Tuition fees are paid by subjects per session (three sessions per year). Applicants are required to submit a non refundable/transferable application fee of HK\$150.
