# Master of Information Studies

## Program structure

The program consists of 10 core subjects (64 points) plus 4 restricted elective subjects (32 points). The total is 96 points over 24–48 months.

### Core subjects

(8 points per subject, unless otherwise specified)

- **INF561** Foundations for Information Studies
- **INF562** Information Sources and Services
- **INF557** Management of Information Agencies
- **INF564** The Information Society
- **INF563** Collections
- **INF566** Professional Study Visit (4 points)
- **INF554** Metadata for Resource Discovery
- **INF567** Research in Practice
- **INF571** Planning for Professional Placement (2 points)
- **INF572** Professional Placement (2 points)

Students who complete all core subjects can exit the program with the a Graduate Diploma of Information Studies (GDIS).

### Restricted elective subjects

(8 points per subject) (Select 4 subjects)

## Study mode and assessments

- This program is delivered part-time.
- Distance learning is supplemented by local face-to-face tutorials (no tutorial for core subjects INF566, INF571 and INF572).
- 3 sessions per year: Session 1 (Feb–Jun), Session 2 (Jul–Oct) and Session 3 (Nov–Feb).
- Subjects are assessed by coursework, with no examinations. Coursework is marked by Charles Sturt subject coordinators.
