Introduction

This 30-hour Certificate is designed for those who have secured Level 2 in the Unit of Competency (UoC) Standards of the Security Operational Works category. Through this programme, students can acquire knowledge equivalent to Level 3's SCS standards including knowledge on security operational works, emergency cases handling, and supervision on the work of each security posts in the Security Operational Works category.

Programme Structure

Students are required to attend 10 meetings over a 3-month period, each 3 hours per week.

Medium of Instruction

Cantonese supplemented with English

Method of Assessment

Students are required to:

- (a) achieve a minimum attendance requirement of 70% of the course;
- (b) submit one coursework assessment; and
- (c) sit for a 2-hour written examination

Award of the Certificate

The Certificate for Module (Management of Security Operational Works (Level 3)) will be awarded to students who are able to satisfy both the attendance requirement and course assessment.

Admission Requirements

To be eligible for admission to this course, applicants should

- (a) holder of Level 2 or above recognized training of Specification of Competency Standards in the Property Management industry; or
- (b) have gained three years' work experience in the Property Management Industry with 2 years' work experience in the Security related area; or
- (c) have gained the RPL level 2 in the Property Management industry.
