d) have gained in the HKDSE Examination level 2 in 4 subjects (not including English Language) with at least 4 years work experience;

and

- ii) hold an Advanced Certificate in Nutrition awarded within the HKU system through HKU SPACE or equivalent;

II. provide evidence of English proficiency, such as

- i) HKCEE English Language (Syllabus B) at Grade E or English Language (Syllabus A) at Grade C or English Language (in or after 2007) at Level 2; or
ii) HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 2;

- III. i) have successfully completed the HKU SPACE Human Biology and Organic Chemistry I short course; or
ii) have a pass in the HKCEE Chemistry and Biology; or
iii) have gained in the HKDSE Examination at Level 2 in both Chemistry (or Level 3 in Combined Science (Chemistry)) and Biology (or Level 3 in Combined Science (Biology)) or equivalent.
