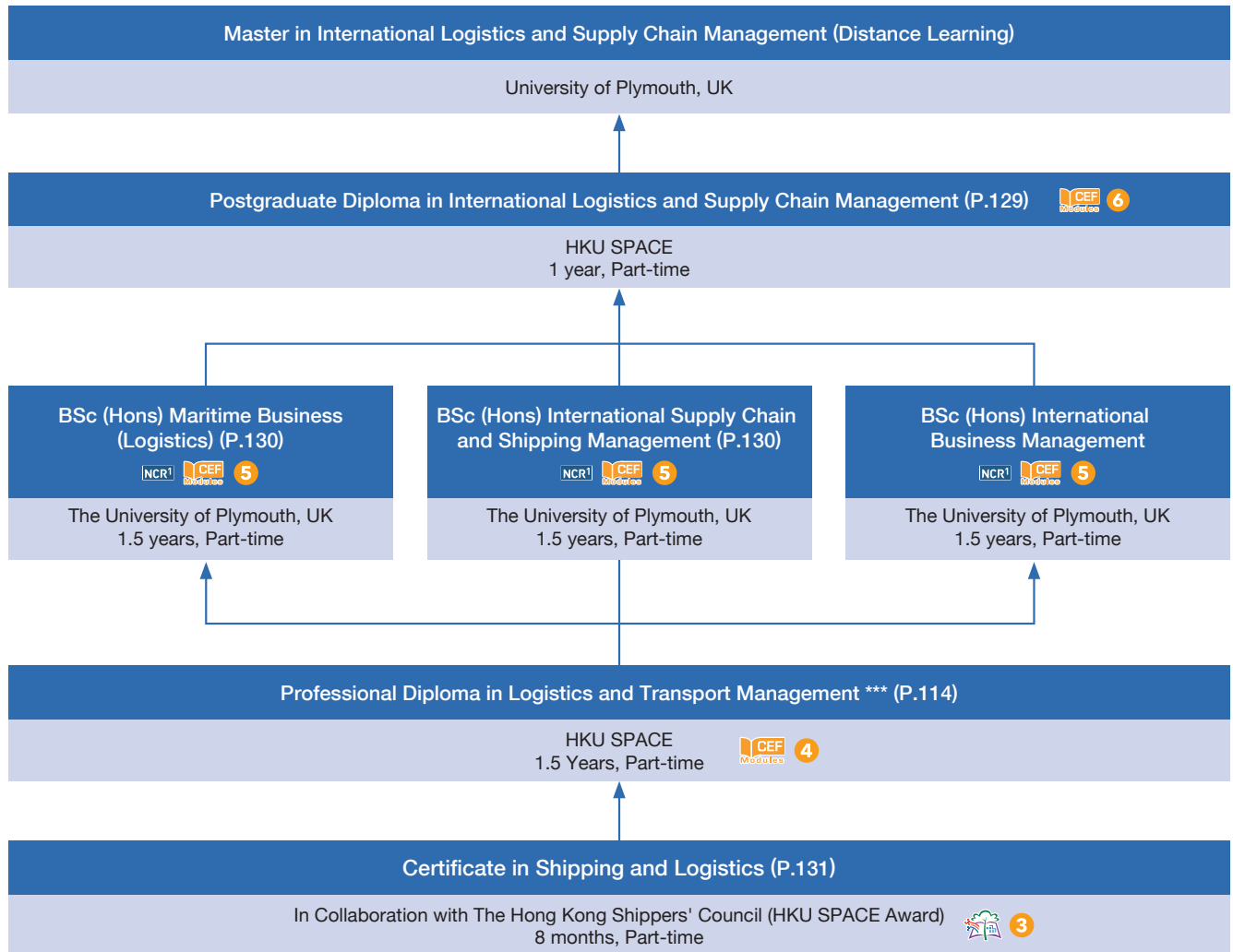


Articulation Route for Transport and Logistics programmes

The Professional Diploma in Logistics and Transport Management programme has been granted full exemption from the educational requirements for Chartered Membership of the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport (CIMLT). Students will take a total of eight courses, either in the Logistics Management Stream or the Transport Management Stream. After graduation, students can continue to study at bachelor degree level.

- R** Applicants shall:
- have satisfied the HKU Entrance Requirements as specified in the prevailing University Regulations, or possess equivalent qualifications; or
 - be a Member of The Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport (MILT); or

- possess a Higher Diploma in Transport Studies granted by the Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education (IVE) (Tsing Yi) and have at least two years of relevant post-qualification work experience; or
- possess a Diploma in Business Studies (Freight Transport) granted by IVE (Haking Wong) and at least two years of relevant post-qualification working experience; or
- possess an Advanced Certificate in Logistics and Transport Studies awarded within the HKU system through HKU SPACE with at least grade C in either subject, Introduction to Transport Studies or Introduction to Logistics Studies; or
- possess an Advanced Certificate in Shipping and Logistics awarded within the HKU system through HKU SPACE with at least Grade C in either one of the two modules; or
- possess a Certificate in Shipping and Logistics awarded within the HKU system through HKU SPACE with at least Grade C in either one of the two modules; or
- possess an Advanced Diploma in Traffic Engineering awarded within the HKU system through HKU SPACE.
- possess a RPL (Logistics) qualification of minimum 30 credits at QF Level 3 or above. Applicants who do not have the above qualifications, but possess at least 5 years of relevant working experience, with at least 3 years at managerial level, will also be considered.

The programme provides an overview of the railway rolling stock from an engineering perspective. Topics on railway rolling stock analysis, design and maintenance will be covered. Students will gain a good understanding of the technical complexities, reliability and maintainability of rolling stock.

- R** Applicants shall hold:
- a relevant bachelor's degree awarded by a recognized institution and at least 2 years of engineering work experience;
- OR
- a professional qualification related to engineering industry.
- If the degree or equivalent qualification is from an institution where the language of teaching and assessment is not English, applicants shall provide evidence of English proficiency, such as:
- an overall band of 6.0 or above with no subtests lower than 5.5 in IELTS; or
 - a score of 550 or above in the paper-based TOEFL, or a score of 213 or above in the computer-based TOEFL, or a core of 80 or above in the internet-based TOEFL; or
 - HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 3 or above; or
 - HKALE Use of English at Grade E or above; or
 - equivalent qualifications.

The programme provides an overview of the mechanical, electrical, electronic and computer system that controls the safe passage and movements of trains on a railway line. It aims to provide a holistic view of the engineering principles, design and operational constraints and considerations as well as component evolutions of the equipment which collectively is known as the railway signalling system.

- R** Applicants shall hold:
- a relevant bachelor's degree awarded by a recognized institution and at least 2 years of engineering work experience;
- OR
- a professional qualification related to engineering industry.
- If the degree or equivalent qualification is from an institution where the language of teaching and assessment is not English, applicants shall provide evidence of English proficiency, such as:
- an overall band of 6.0 or above with no subtests lower than 5.5 in IELTS; or
 - a score of 550 or above in the paper-based TOEFL, or a score of 213 or above in the computer-based TOEFL, or a core of 80 or above in the internet-based TOEFL; or
