A thesis supervisor will be allocated upon a student's acceptance and will be the mentor to the student throughout their DBA journey. - Relevant middle to senior-level management experience. Applicants without management experience but with appropriate and sufficient extensive experience in the business context may be considered at the discretion of the admissions tutors; and
- Strong commitment to educational inquiry and critical reflection on practice as a means of professional learning
- Ability to work collaboratively in exploring and developing experience
- Personal statement about the applicants' professional experience and commitment to take up the challenge of a DBA (800 words)
- Research idea to describe the research area applicants hope to investigate for their DBA (1,000 words)

International applicants will be required to provide evidence of their English language ability with a minimum overall IELTS score of 6.5 (with a minimum of 5.5 in each element); or equivalent. For students studying at RQF 6 level and above, the University of Plymouth is permitted to accept other qualifications that are deemed to meet UKVI (UK Visas and Immigration) requirement.
